


Did You Know?

Michigan's Dental Registry (MiDR) provides a web-based platform that facilitates communication between primary care providers and dentists regarding pediatric patient oral health. It is designed to document provided care, and place and track referrals to a dentist as needed.

MiDR partnered with **Delta Dental of Michigan**, Michigan's largest dental insurer, to offer primary care providers **direct** access to the Healthy Kids Dental network of dentists.





Innovating oral health care delivery in Michigan

MiDR brings together patient-centric care delivery information to allow more complete monitoring of pediatric oral health.

Michigan's Oral Health Surveillance System

Michigan's Dental Registry (MiDR) is available as a **Meaningful Use Specialized Registry!**

MiDR serves to increase the communication and transparency between medical and dental providers, allowing for better coordination of patient care and continuity of care. In early 2016, MiDR was classified by CMS as a Meaningful Use Specialized Registry. MiDR houses valuable information related to a child's access to and utilization of preventive oral health services in both the medical and dental environments. Data collected by the tool is submitted to the State of Michigan, creating a valid, reportable data system for monitoring pediatric oral health access to services, and overall dental caries rates.



Potential benefits to participating in MiDR include:

- Qualify for Meaningful Use incentive dollars
- Track population health measures for patients
- Compare patients' experience to that of other providers
- Ensure practice prosperity within the changing healthcare landscape

Who is eligible?

MiDR is available to physicians (MD,DO), dentists, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants.
